Birth Certificates...Ext. 221

Blood Lead...Ext. 254

Finger stick screening for blood lead level (1st & 3rd Wednesday). Eligibility: Public



Blood Pressure Screening...Ext. 254

Screening for blood pressure. Eligibility: Public

Breast Cancer Screening (see Mammograms)

Breastfeeding...Ext. 271

Questions and referrals regarding breastfeeding Eligibility: Public.

Cholesterol Testing (Health Watch)...Ext. 254

Venous blood draw for cholesterol and other cardiovascular risks. Eligibility: Public

Chore Housekeeping...785-5300

Available for seniors in Cass/Putman Townships only Cleaning, personal care, errands, grocery shopping. Eligibility: Cass & Putman Township residents only who meet eligibility.

Colorectal Cancer Screening...Ext. 254

Take home fecal occult self test kit which is returned to FCHD for screening Eligibility: Public.

Condoms...Ext. 244

Condoms provided to males & females of reproductive age. Walk in room 108. Eligibility: Public.

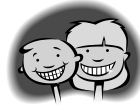
Contraceptives (See Family Planning)...Ext. 244

Annual wellness exams, pap smears, contraceptives, STD testing and treatment, pregnancy testing, education and counseling. Eligibility: Public.

Cuba Sub-office of Fulton County Health Department...785-5300

Many of the same services that are offered in Canton, Chore Housekeeping and Medications Management.

Eligibility: Public (Many services limited to residents of Cass & Putman Township).



Death Certificates...Ext. 221

Certified copies of death certificates.

Dental Center...Ext. 292

Dental services to Medicaid, KidCare and low income. Eligibility: Low income public. Fee for service.

Dental Sealant Program...Ext. 238

In school dental sealant program. Eligibility: Must qualify for free or reduced lunch program.

Diseases/Infectious...Ext. 226

Investigation for reportable disease, information, education. Eligibility: Public.

Energy Assistance...Ext. 245

One time energy assistance benefits to be used for energy bills. Eligibility: Low-Income, based on income.

Case Management...Ext. 271

Education & referral program for pregnant women, infants and small children under 2 years of age. Eligibility: Public.

Family Planning...Ext. 244

Annual wellness exams, pap smears, contraceptives, STD testing and treatment, pregnancy testing, education and counseling. Eligibility: Public

Flu Immunizations...Ext. 300 (schedule announced late summer) Eligibility: Public

Food Permits/Sanitation...Ext. 230

Food/drink permits, temporary food permits, and annual inspections. Eligibility: Public.

Food Sanitation Classes...Ext. 230

5 hour refresher course. Eligibility: Public.

Garbage Nuisance...Ext. 230

Documentation and investigation of nuisance. Eligibility: Public.

Glucose Testing...Ext. 254

Venous blood draw (see Health Watch).

Health Education - General...Ext. 238

Health Education to communities, businesses and schools. Eligibility: Public.

Health Watch...Ext. 254

Cardiovascular/Diabetes/Wellness. Venous blood draw for cholesterol, cardiovascular, diabetes and cancer screenings. Eligibility: Public.

Hearing Screenings...Ext. 282

Eligibility: Public & School - screening, referral and follow-

up.

Hemoglobin Screenings...Ext. 254

Finger stick screening for hemoglobin level. Eligibility: Public.

HIV/AIDS Testing...Ext. 244

Venous blood draw screening, counseling, and education. Eligibility: Public.

Home Visit/APORS...Ext. 271

A follow up visit for newborns at the request of the hospital.

Home Visit/Newborn...Ext. 271

Nurse visit to home of newborn.

Immunizations...Ext. 254

Infant-Child-Adult: Various vaccines. Eligibility: Public.

International Travel & Immunizations...Ext. 221

Documentation of immunizations for state. Eligibility: Public.

Mammogram...Ext. 244

Screening, diagnostic, financial assistance for mammograms. Eligibility: Fulton County women age 35-64.

Medication Management...785-5300

Set up and monitoring of medications through the Cuba Sub-office. Cass & Putman township senior citizens.

MPE-Medical Presumptive Eligibility...Ext. 253

Medical insurance for pregnant women.

Pap Tests...Ext. 244

Cervical cancer screening program available through the Family Planning Program, STD Clinic and Women's Health Program. Eligibility: Public.



Peer Mentoring...Ext. 238

Training high school students to work as peers with students who are incoming freshmen. Offered to Fulton County schools.

The Pill (See Family Planning)...Ext. 244

Pneumonia Immunization...Ext. 300

Eligibility: Public

Pregnancy Panel and Teen Pregnancy...Ext. 238

Parents who discuss their experiences as a teen parent. Follow-up with abstinence & contraceptive presentations in Fulton County Schools.

Pregnancy Testing...Ext. 244

Urinalysis for pregnancy. Eligibility: Public and Family Planning Clients. Eligibility: Public

Presentations To The Community...Ext. 238

Health Topic Presentations for the community. Presentations are available at no charge for grant supported program. Other presentations may require a fee.

Presentations In the School...Ext. 238

Health topics in schools. Presentations are available at no charge for grant supported programs. Other presentations may require a fee

Prevention Coalition...Ext 238

Quarterly planning and information sharing meetings.

Prostate Specific Antigen (PSA) Testing...Ext 254

Venous blood screening for prostate cancer. 2nd and 4th Monday. Eligibility: Public.

Reproductive Health Education...Ext. 238

Presentation on puberty & reproductive health systems for grades 5-6.



School Nurse...Ext. 267

School nurse services provided contractually to school districts in Fulton County. Eligibility: Participating schools.

Septic Permit...Ext. 230

Septic Permit Application & Inspections for permit. Septic Evaluation Eligibility: Public.

Smoking Cessation

Referrals to the Illinois Quitline and to local resources for smoking cessation. Ext. 226 or 1-866-QUIT-YES.



Solid Waste/Recycling...Ext. 241

License and registration of businesses that haul and recycle/ educational presentations. Eligibility: Public.

STD/Sexually Transmitted Disease Testing...Ext. 244

Testing, treatment, counseling, education, and HIV testing for men and women. Eligibility: Public.

Tanning Facility Inspection...Ext. 261

Annual inspection for state license.

Teen Pregnancy Prevention...Ext. 238

Teen Mother speaks to high school and junior high school classes about her experiences as a teen mother. Realistic presentation of problems associated with growing up a teen mother.

Tuberculosis Screenings and Testing...Ext 254

TB skin tests are available at no charge by appointment. Eligibility: Public. No Fee.

Teen Parent Panel Ext...238

Parents who discuss their experiences as a teen parent. Follow-up with abstinence & contraceptive presentations. Eligibility: Fulton County schools

Tetanus Immunization (see Immunizations-Adult)...Ext. 254

Eligibility: Public/By Appointment.



Vision Screenings...Ext. 282

Eligibility: Public and school screening, referral and follow-up. .

Volunteer Program...Ext. 226

The Health Department is always looking for volunteers who are used in our programs. Eligibility: Public.

Weatherization of Homes...Ext. 251

Inspection & possible repair of heating system, insulate walls & attics, repair of doors & windows. Eligibility: Public

Well Testing and Permits...Ext. 230

Water test kits/ Well permit applications and inspections/ well evaluations. Eligibility: Public.

WIC & WIC Class (Women, Infants and Children Supplemental Nutrition Program)...Ext. 271

Food packages and nutrition education. Eligibility: WIC income guidelines.

Women's Health Clinics...Ext. 244

Physical exams, clinical breast exams and pelvic exams. Eligibility: Public
